Emily Augusta, wife of Ernest John Hellier was living in Bougainville Street Manuka at the time of her death on 26th September 1965 aged 80 years. She is buried with her husband who died on 6th September 1961. He was 89 years of age.

She is buried with her grandmother Helen Rennie who died in 1931. Helen Rennie was the wife of Robert Andrew Rennie - a watchman of Caledonian Tea Rooms at Manuka. Helen Rennie died on 21st October 1931 aged 53 years.

Patricia was the daughter of Fanny and WR Craske and was born in Kent England. She married Robin John Tillyard in 1909 in Sydney. The couple had four daughters and in 1928 moved to Canberra. She died on 10th March 1971 aged 91 years. Robin John Tillyard was born in England in 1881 and came to Australia in 1904. He became the first Chief of the Entomological Division of the CS&IR. He died as the result of a motor accident on 13th January 1937 aged 56.

people buried in the church cemetery. Eva Yelland, daughter of William and Anna Maria Dawson (nee Webber) was born in 1869 in Robe. In 1897 she married Edward Howard Yelland and their first child, Herbert was born in Kalgoolie where he died in 1898 aged five months. In 1904 they had a daughter Eva and in 1910 a son Errol. In 1927 their daughter set up a business in Manuka and the couple joined their daughter. Eva died on 7th June 1964 aged 94. At that time she lived in Hann Crescent in Griffith. Her daughter married in 1936 to William Ives.
