

Barton & Braddon Electoral Roll 1935

An earlier name for part of this suburb was Telopea Park and it includes the cottages built in 1921/1922 opposite the Power House - usually referred to as *The Power House Cottages*. 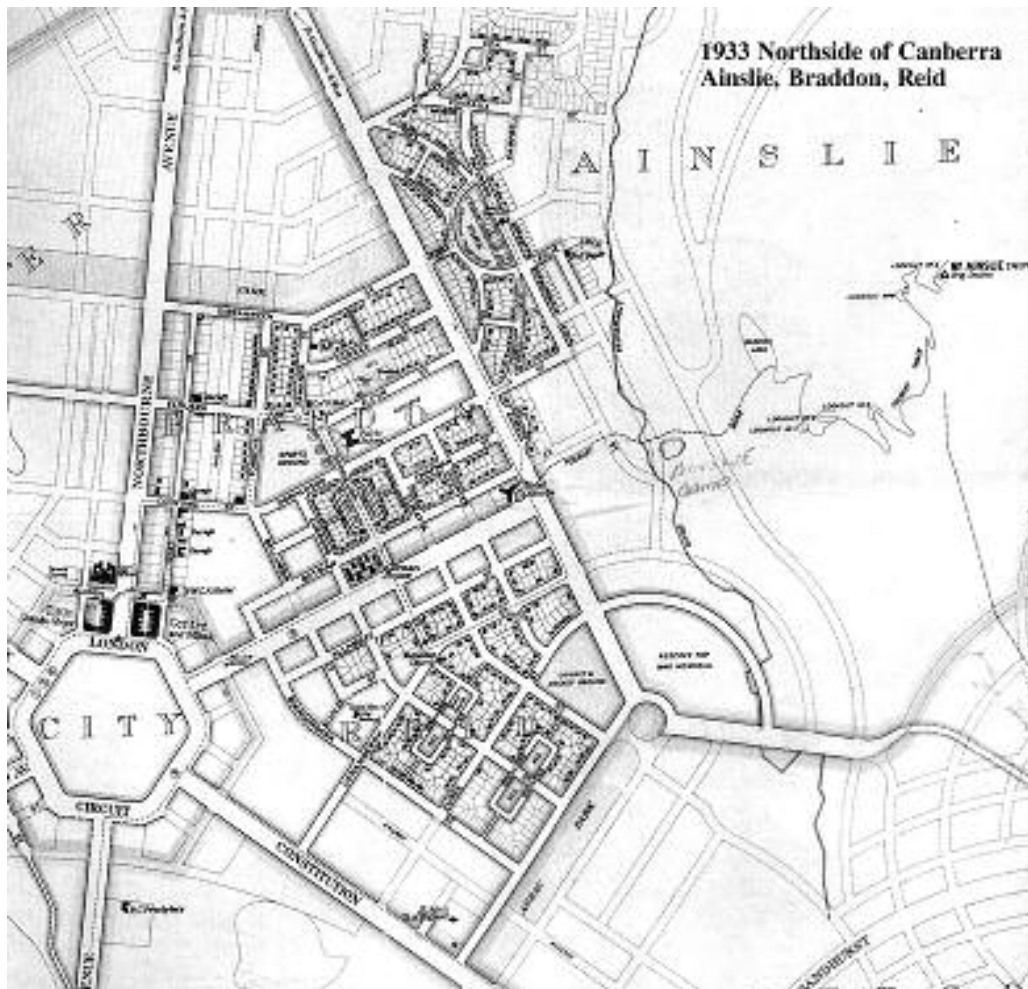
